

LUBE-IT 5 Maintenance Update 1

December, 2011

Changes addressed by this Maintenance Update:

- Mark Completed Tasks
 - Corrected user rights management
- Text File Import
 - Capacity Unit of measure not updating properly in all instances
 - Task Details are not imported if the Equipment lacks a Number or a Name
 - Trying to import duplicate equipment causes an error: "cdsEqp: Must apply updates before refreshing data."
 - Using tab as a delimiter causes errors
- Close Schedule
 - Improved messages displayed if no tasks need a last done date
 - Improved schedule process to let the highest completed meter reading to be used as last done reading instead of assumes reading
 - Due dates have time values after schedule built
 - Corrected Typo on close schedule panel
 - Moved the sched.log file to the temp folder
- Completing Tasks
 - Added message to completed tasks form to show tasks requiring a meter reading
 - Selecting all tasks shows "Default Route" when preference is set to not show "Default Route"
- Consumption Feature
 - Consumption report not showing data
- Database
 - Turn off Auto-Complete for all triggers
 - Turn off AutoFill for all components
- Equipment Explorer
 - Copying equipment puts tasks in "Default Route" even though preferences have a different route selected
 - When copying equipment or systems with no number or name could cause duplications
 - Copied tasks have no sequence value when copied to a new route
- Equipment Manager
 - Product drop down not sorted by product name
 - Newly added components do not show up in dropdown
 - Date last done calendar lets users pick future dates
 - Component dropdown sorted by code not name
 - Correct misc. AutoFill errors
 - Adding task to route that has no tasks doesn't fill in sequence
 - Capacity UOM dropdown not sorted
- Handheld Routes
 - Check for existence of prerequisite application components
 - Items with "&" in their description show up as an "_"

- Yellow highlight for critical Equipment sometimes shows up on Location
- Route list isn't sorted by route name
- Capacity doesn't show if there is capacity UOM
- Errors if no value set for Skip Reason
- Check out without first setting up Lockout Setup causes error
- View menu Due tasks sometimes shows completed tasks
- Application UOM truncates if too long
- Show capacity UOM description on task form
- Unable to complete tasks on Saturday
- More tasks form procedure button does not highlight yellow when task has procedures
- More tasks form – Add red border around trouble button if a trouble record has been added
- More tasks form – highlight lockout button in yellow if there is lockout data
- Lockout button disabled when lockout data is available
- Task form – Shutdown code of “Yes” or “LTO” not highlighted in yellow
- Failing Lube-Test tasks that don't have a linked task causes error
- Mobile Sync Manager
 - Checking out routes from “Demo” data causes error
 - Error if a Product used on the routes has been deleted
 - Shows “Default Route” when preferences have selected not to show “Default Route”
 - Task that have a trouble code with an apostrophe cause error when synced
- Main Application
 - Set Date Last done and Set Last Done Readings – Now enabled during installation
 - Re-added option to install software onto handheld device
 - Meter Manager – Should be sorted by meter description not code
 - Preferences – Don't allow an invalid work week
 - Preferences – Consumption tracking setting sometimes were not saved
 - Preferences – Number of day in workweek not calculating properly
 - Staff name displays correctly for all users (not just “ADMIN”)
 - Corrected typo in About LUBE-IT form
- Quick Speck Viewer
 - Help not displaying correct items
 - Cascading error if there is an error connecting to the sql server
- Custom Reports
 - Not looking at correct folder
- Reports
 - YTD consumption reports
 - Past Due Task report – Dialog showing up behind main application windows
 - Consumption YTD by component & Product
 - Component Lube History – Tree not filtering to show equipment for selected system
- Route Explorer
 - Improved hours field calculation for tasks of interval of “Days”
- Route Wizard
 - Improved wording on help panels
 - Move to selected route dropdown now sorts properly
 - Blank rows displayed if number or name of equipment or system are blank
- Schedule Explorer

- Improved duration calculation for tasks with interval of “Days”
- Capacity Convert
 - Adding a new UOM during conversion process now works correctly
- Workstation 5 Installer
 - Now works even if a newer version of SQL Server Compact is already installed

You must have LUBE-IT version 5 installed to use this Maintenance Update – it does not apply to any previous versions of LUBE-IT.
